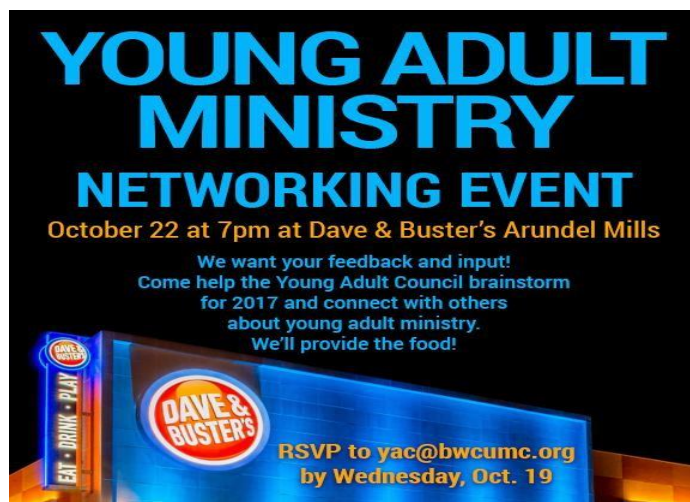
## Voices In Praise Yard Sale Saturday, Oct. 22 \* 8am - 12pm

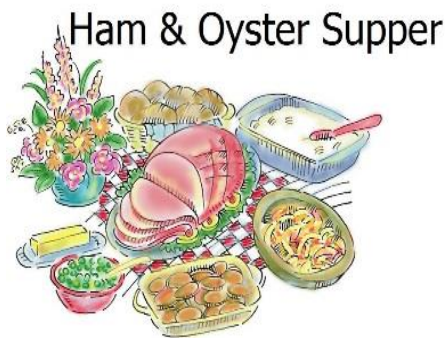

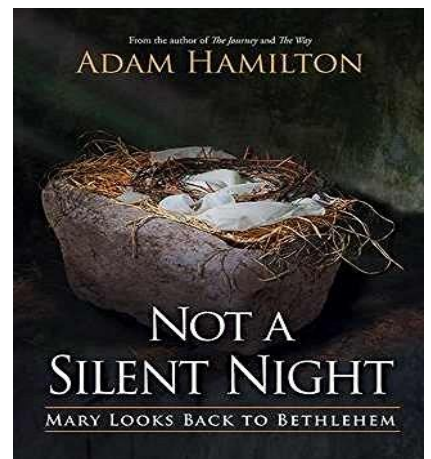
## **Advent Book Study**
