Submit your completed application packet no later than March 1, 2018, to the PDK representative listed above. All applications are reviewed by the chapter screening committee

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- **Goals Statement** – You have decided as a goal that you want to become a teacher. Please share your vision as to what that means to you and how you see yourself accomplishing this goal (about 100 to 150 words).
- **Reference Letter** – Please submit one letter of recommendation. The letter must be from a person familiar with your academic abilities and school activities, and should address your interest in teaching and the qualities that will make you a successful educator.
- **Transcript** – Request a copy of your high school transcript from your school counselor. Your transcript must include class size, class rank, and grade point average.

There are two types of scholarships: general endowed scholarships and scholarships with special criteria. All applicants will be considered for the general endowed scholarships. If you would like to be considered for any of the scholarships with special criteria, you will be asked to answer additional questions. Please note that these scholarships are highly competitive because they are offered nation-wide.
