1. All students will have to sit for the entire 80 minutes of the exam. NO ONE IS TO BE DISMISSED PRIOR TO TERMINATION TIME.

2. Teachers will proctor their own examinations.

3. Students who do not have an afternoon exam on Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday, may leave T-D at the end of period 6 for grades 6, 7, and 8 and at the end of period 5 for grades 9 – 12.

4. All students are to report to their homerooms every morning and for all classes as regularly scheduled.

5. Anyone giving an answer or receiving an answer will automatically receive an “F” on the mid-term. Anyone with “cheat” notes in his or her possession will be considered as a cheater and automatically fail.

**** Any student requesting additional time for testing:**

1. Must submit the request in writing at least one week prior to the exam itself.
2. Must support the request with official documentation from a school psychologist or similar.
3. Must understand that the maximum extension in time will only be 30 minutes.
4. May not return to the exam once it is completed.

6. Friday is a full day of school with an exam in the morning and a Glory Days program in the afternoon. The afternoons of Thursday, February 1st and Friday, February 2nd may be used to give an exam should there be a school closing due to snow on another day during that week.
