Our brothers and sisters in the Roman Catholic tradition celebrate the Feast Day of St Francis of Assisi. St. Francis (1182-1226) was a monk who founded the contemporary order of Franciscans. He was known for his vow of poverty and his ministry to the very poorest members of the community. There are also many legends surrounding his special connection to animals. And so, in many Christian traditions, the first Sunday in October is often set-aside for a special Blessing of the Animals service.

Our worship service on October 2nd will take place in the Pepin Village Park where we will have a grand celebration and blessing of our animal companions. We will sing and thank God for all the animals that make our lives richer by their presence. Cats, dogs, goldfish, gerbils, horses, hamsters, parakeets, etc., etc.,..... All are Welcome!
