

Founded in 1987, FMSC is a non-profit organization that provides nutritionally complete meals specifically formulated for malnourished children. Ingredients are purchased with donations and volunteers hand-pack every meal. Meals are donated to FMSC partners around the world who connect with kids in need. FMSC consistently receives awards for transparency and accountability. Meals cost less than 25 cents and 99% of FMSC meals have reached their destination.

For many years now, a family in our congregation donates Easter M&M's with a challenge to tackle hunger in our world — and to bring Easter in real time — new life — to people who are living in the midst of great adversity.


