- Shabbat concludes at 6:34 p.m.
- Ma'ariv is at 6:55 p.m. followed by multiple readings of Megillat Esther and then a community Pizza and Ice Cream Party in the Lindenbaum Gymnasium of the Ramaz Middle School, 114 East 85 Street, with music by beloved Morah Chaya and her magical keyboard.
