Text: Colossians 3

Big Idea of the Message: Life in Christ

Application Point: Why false teaching is dangerous and what we can learn from Paul's teaching about the sufficiency of Christ

Questions from the Text:

1. What struggles do Christians face today to be like the world...or worse, act like we still belong to the world?
2. What does it mean to set your heart and your mind on things above?
3. We realize that this world is wasting away but through Christ we have true life. How would setting our heart in this position change our priorities?
4. How would your life be different this week if you took this list seriously?
5. Would you be happier or more at peace if you did?
6. How can our sinful desires keep us from engaging in these things Paul encourages them to do?

Challenge from the Sermon:

1. Is there something in your past you need to and want to break free from? What is your strategy to break free?
2. Are you empowering your past over you because you can't break free? How can you empower your future by fixing your heart, eyes and mind on Christ?
3. Paul lists four groupings that need to dissolve in the church. Which one do you think BH struggles with and how can she dissolve this distinction?
 - a. Racial
 - b. Religious
 - c. Cultural
 - d. Economic
