

Hello Rancho Cordova Artist,

You are invited to submit your latest and greatest artwork for the upcoming art show. "Zoom In" is the 18<sup>th</sup> exhibit at Rancho Cordova City Hall. "Zoom In" will run from Jan. 23 through April 7 and will be juried by Marsha Mason. All media is welcome except those noted below.

### Submission information and requirements

- There is no entry fee.
- Artists are encouraged to bring in up to three of your most outstanding and recent art pieces
- Size limit: up to 4' x 4', weight limit: 25 pounds
- 2D work must be a **minimum 12" x 12"**
- All submissions must be *your own current* and original artwork
- Types of work accepted: all types of two and three dimensional artwork
- Not accepted at this time: video, film and projected work
- We are not responsible for artwork behind glass - Plexiglas is preferred
- **ALL 2D WORK MUST BE WIRED, FRAMED AND READY TO HANG. No saw tooth hangers**
- Gallery-wrapped canvases should have finished sides without staples showing
- Artist may be called to assist in display of unusually fragile work
- During the show each piece will include a gallery tag with artist's name, art title, photo process or media and price (or NFS - Not for Sale)
- Artist's contact information will be made available for interested buyers
- All submitted work must include a completed tag provided below. Please attach to the backside of each submitted piece. Completed tags are absolutely necessary. Please print clearly.
- **All art pieces not picked up within 48 hours from the pickup dates noted below become the property of the Cordova Community Council \_\_\_\_\_ (initials required)**



## Wiring 2D Art

With Rancho Cordova City Hall's art installation system, 2D artwork hangs best if wired as shown below.

- Place eyelet screws NO LOWER THAN 1/3 down from top of frame. Screw these into the inside sides of picture frame or canvas frame structure.
- For metal frames, place wire hardware NO LOWER THAN 1/3 down from top of frame.
- IF YOU WIRE IS PLACED FURTHER THAN 1/3 FROM THE TOP, YOUR PIECE WILL HANG UNSUCCESSFULLY FROM ANY WALL HANGING SYSTEM.
- Be sure that wire is not so loose as to stretch beyond the top of your frame.



And remember - no saw tooth hangers.
