



A Non-Serving Christian – Say What?

Ephesians 2:10 (TLB) *It is God himself who has made us what we are and given us new lives from Christ Jesus; and long ages ago he planned that we should spend these lives in helping others.*

Romans 12:1 (GNT) *So then, my friends, because of God's great mercy to us I appeal to you: Offer yourselves as a living sacrifice to God, dedicated to his service and pleasing to him. This is the true worship that you should offer.*

Why doesn't God just take us to heaven the moment we accept His grace?

- Once we are saved, we are here to fulfill His purposes. God has a MINISTRY for you in His church and a MISSION for you in the world!

We are called to serve God...

1 Corinthians 12:27 (NLT) *All of you together are Christ's body, and each of you is a part of it.*

- Each of us has a role to play in serving in church and each role is important.
- Matthew 20:28 (TLB) *Your attitude must be like my own, for I, the Messiah, did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give my life as a ransom for many.*
- It is not enough to keep learning more and more, we must ACT on what we know and PRACTICE what we claim to believe.

SHAPE

- S Spiritual Gifts -- Ephesians 4:7 (CEV) *Christ has generously divided out his gifts to us.*
- H Heart – Describes the bundles of desire, hopes, interests, ambitions, dreams and affections we have. The source of your motivations. What you love to do and what you care about most.
- A Abilities – The natural talents you were born with. 1 Corinthians 10:31 (NIV) *So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.*
- P Personality – God loves variety. Look around, there are introverts, extroverts, routines, variety, thinkers, feelers, individual and team players. 1 Corinthians 12:6 (PHILLIPS) *God works through different men in different ways, but it is the same God who achieves his purposes through them all.*
- E Experiences – God has allowed the experiences of your life to shape you to help others.

How do servants think?

Romans 12:2 (NLT) *Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.*

Servants have this mindset...

- Think more about others than themselves.
- Think like STEWARDS not owners.
- Base their IDENTITY in Christ.

- Think of ministry as an OPPORTUNITY, not an obligation.
