Biggest year yet for NACS! School starts August 20th: Our Naples Adventist Christian School will be starting in just a few weeks with Class Registration scheduled for the 16th. This year is already promising to be a banner year for NACS. The Florida Conference Education Department has authorized NACS to add an additional teacher. This is a huge step forward for our school, and will guarantee an excellent teacher-to-student ratio. With only two grade levels per teacher, our classrooms will be focused and excel in quality education.

But the addition of a new teacher is not the only thing happening this year. Very soon construction will begin to add more classroom space by the addition of a modular structure on the west side of the building. This will be a huge improvement and allow our school to continue to grow. Under the leadership of Mary Ann Rule, our school board chairperson, Laura Carlisle, our former school treasurer, and Audrey Wainwright, our principal, the project will greatly enhance what the school can offer. Over the spring months, the school board (in consultation with the Florida Conference Education Department) hired three new teachers. Summer at the school is a time for preparation, planning, projects and big news!

- Our building project is now out of planning and into production. We are so blessed to engage with the same general contractor and civil engineer that oversaw the building renovation 10 years ago. Plans are being drawn and preliminary meetings with the city for permitting are taking place. We will be placing a hurricane force rated modular building on the west side of the school, which will have two rooms large enough for classrooms and a center multi-purpose area for a lunch room, get-togethers, and light PE in inclement weather. We are hoping the building will be ready in January for the second semester.

- We have been awarded a STEM (Science Technology Engineering Math) grant of \$10,000 to offer a robotics experience at the school. This award is only granted to three Conference schools and we are blessed to be one!

The first day of school is August 20th and we are diligently getting ready and excited to welcome the students to a fresh new school year! We love guests, so please let us know if you would like to stop by and see the great things happening.

“What is Christian Stewardship?”

And who and what are involved in Christian Stewardship? A good definition is vital to a clear understanding of the subject matter. So let us define Christian stewardship. Stewardship is not a synonym for money... It is a relationship. A relationship between God, the Creator, and the human, the created being. Random House Dictionary defines a *steward* as “a person who is entrusted to take charge or manage property and finance, or administers anything as the agent of others.” The second word, “Christian” is a simple word. It comes from the Greek word *Christianos*, “a follower of Christ.” It was used first in Antioch of Syria to describe the disciples of Jesus Christ. So a Christian steward is a person who is a follower of Jesus Christ, who has been entrusted by God to manage, oversee, take charge or to care for what God has entrusted to him or her. The answer to the second question is: God and human kind, based on a mutual relationship between them. God’s ownership and our role as caretakers includes every aspect of our life on earth. It is both a blessing and a responsibility. We work together with God. We are stewards of our lives. Since we live within time and space, we are also stewards of our time and our environment. We were created in God’s image. This image is what we are and finds expression in every aspect of our being. We are, therefore, stewards of our bodies, of our spiritual life, of our mental and intellectual capacities, and of our social being.
