Donating to the Bria Fund is unique because every cent donated is only used for FIP research. Winn takes no administrative fees. Universities can take up to 50% of research donations for overhead, not actual research. Bria Fund dollars cannot be used for overhead, only research. With your help, the Bria Fund will award two additional FIP studies this fall and additional ones in 2018. Researchers receive an average of \$35,000 per study. Winn isn't limited by not enough researchers working on a cure or other critical FIP areas, only by the availability of donor dollars needed to financially support worthy proposals.

For this virtual raffle, we selected Luna to demonstrate the progress being made in curing FIP and eventually ending it. She is a Savannah, currently living well with FIP, and potentially cured because of a drug initially developed for humans. The Bria Fund helped support the initial testing of this drug and a few others from the same human pharmaceutical company. The researcher speculates that there may be other drugs already developed that may also be effective in stopping the FIP virus. Finding these drugs will take time and money.
