Mary (Czaja) Felzkowski (R-Irma) and Rep. Amy Loudenberg (R-Clinton), and new members Rep. Mark Born (R-Beaver Dam) and Rep. Mike Rohrkaste (R-Neenah.).
 - **Democrat appointments:** Rep. Gordon Hintz (D-Oshkosh) and Rep. Katrina Shankland (D-Stevens Point)
