- SENATE AND ASSEMBLY DISTRICT NUMBERS ARE CODED **RED** FOR REPUBLICAN PARTY DISTRICTS (MAJORITY PARTY) AND **BLUE** FOR DEMOCRATIC PARTY DISTRICTS (MINORITY PARTY).

- Each Senate District is comprised of 3 Assembly Districts

Dale Kooyenga (R-Brookfield) as vice-chair, continuing members Rep. Mary (Czaja) Felzkowski (R-Irma) and Rep. Amy Loudenbeck (R-Clinton), and new members Rep. Mark Born (R-Beaver Dam) and Rep. Mike Rohrkaste (R-Neenah.).
  - **Democrat appointments:** Rep. Gordon Hintz (D-Oshkosh) and Rep. Katrina Shankland (D-Stevens Point)
