



Peanut Free Lunchroom Guidelines:

There are children in our school with peanut and tree nut allergies ranging from moderate to severe and life-threatening. What you need to know:

- The school has reserved three tables in the cafeteria for children with peanut and/or nut allergies.
- No child with any peanut or nut product, during any lunch, can sit at these tables. We must work together to protect our children!
 - In addition to wiping down tables and opening yogurts, etc. we now need to help our teachers and monitor these tables. Please make sure only children with peanut and nut free lunches are sitting there.
 - Please check ingredient labels for all frozen novelties, most ice cream products are produced in a facility with peanuts (these cannot be consumed at the nut free tables).
 - After each lunch each peanut/nut free table and chairs needs to be wiped down thoroughly. There is a separate cleaning container labeled "peanut allergy" to wipe the peanut free tables down; please use only that bucket and rag on those tables. If available, the Clorox wipes at the back table can be used there. If not the peanut allergy bucket must be used.
 - We have children in this school that cannot even touch peanut residue, and this is severe enough to take a child's life. It only takes 1/8,000 of a peanut to set off a reaction.

Please remember that this is not a life choice, this is a serious allergy. Your help and support is necessary and appreciated beyond measure!
