What: CSF is a scholar/service society with 1400 chapters. Recognizing academically talented and motivated students and providing community service are the goals of CSF. Qualified members are recognized at graduation and are eligible for scholarships, both from the College Park chapter and from the state organization.

Who: Students who meet the criteria outlined below are eligible for CSF membership. Students must apply for membership EACH semester, based on grades earned in the previous semester.

When: Applications are accepted for fall membership from **Sept. 1 - Sept. 30 NO EXCEPTIONS**
Applications are accepted for spring membership from **Feb. 1 - Feb. 28 NO EXCEPTIONS**
(Later applications are accepted for spring membership from contacted Seniors only)

How: Fill out the application below completely. Turn it in to the CPHS treasurer's office with the \$5.00 membership fee in cash or check (checks payable to CPHS) AND a copy of your most recent report card or transcript attached. *Your application will not be processed without the fee and report card attached.*

To qualify for CSF membership, follow these instructions:

- **Earn 10 points** from last semester's high school grades using the following scale:
A=3 CSF points, B=1 CSF point, C=0 CSF points, D or F=disqualified for membership this semester
- No CSF points are given for PE classes, courses taken in lieu of PE, courses that were retaken to improve a grade, office/TA courses, or courses taken on a pass/fail basis.
- At least 4 of your qualifying CSF points must come from List I (*see back*).
- At least 7 of your qualifying CSF points must come from a combination of Lists I & II (*see back*).
- The remaining points may come from any combination of Lists I, II &/or III (*see back*).
- An A or B grade in an AP, Honors or IB course earns 1 extra point, *but only for a maximum of 2 extra points.* (A C=0 CSF points, even in an AP, Honors or IB course.)
- **No more than 5 classes can be used to qualify.**

To qualify for Sealbearer status at graduation you must have:

At least 4 semesters of membership during your sophomore through senior years based on grades earned only in sophomore through senior years—**with at least 1 semester of membership based on grades earned during your 12th-grade year.**

This means to be a CSF Sealbearer at graduation you must be a CSF member for at least 3 of the following 4 semesters:

- Spring of sophomore year (membership based on grades received in January of your 10th-grade year)
- Fall of junior year (membership based on grades received in June of your 10th-grade year)
- Spring of junior year (membership based on grades received in January of your 11th-grade year)
- Fall of senior year (membership based on grades received in June of your 11th-grade year)

IN ADDITION TO THOSE 3 SEMESTERS you MUST be a member

- One semester of your senior year (this semester of membership must be based on grades received *DURING* your 12th-grade year; except for very particular circumstances these would be grades received in January of your 12th-grade year.)
