Job Description for INTEGRATED CARE SPECIALIST

- The Integrated Care Specialist will coordinate and integrate services provided to families by multiple service providers including primary care doctors, counselors, educators and other services providers and to identify and eliminate barriers to effective service delivery.
- Assists in performing outreach activities to include visits to healthcare facilities, other agencies, programs, schools, etc. to develop positive relationships and encourage referrals.
- Makes the appropriate connections to the services that the family may qualify for and follows up to make sure that the family received the service (or finds other resources for the family as deemed necessary).
- Schedule and coordinate bi-weekly face to face meetings.
- Provide psycho-education and training for family and significant persons involved in case.
- Provide life skills (such as budgeting, independent living, etc.) as it relates to the service plan.
- Acts as an advocate for the family when appropriate.
- Documents all direct and indirect services provided to families .

- Assists in completion of other documentation required by the program.
- Participate in community meetings as requested by VP for Programs or CEO.
- Performs other duties as assigned.
- Attends staff meetings regularly.

EXPERIENCE AND QUALIFICATIONS:

- Preferred: Master's in Social Work, Mental Health Counseling, Marriage and Family Therapy, or related field and minimum of 1 year experience working as case worker, targeted case manager, or a position in a related mental health field.
- Minimum: Bachelor degree in Social Work, Psychology, or related field and minimum of 1 year experience working as case worker, targeted case manager, or a position in a related mental health field.
- Experience with High Fidelity Wraparound, preferred.
- Bi-lingual preferred.
