BROWARD COUNSELING SERVICES AND NAVIGATION LEAD

- Actively monitor and quality improve risk reduction counseling program productivity and reporting accuracy
- Oversee, monitor, and report timely input of counseling and navigation data;
- Personally recruit, enroll, and provide risk reduction counseling to HIV+ men;
- Perform HIV and STD testing both in office and in late night mobile shifts;
- Perform online and in-person outreach to gay Latinos and to other gay/bisexual men in Broward who are living with HIV, and
- Facilitate support group meetings.

CENTRAL MIAMI OUTREACH AND INTERVENTION SPECIALIST

- Perform HIV and STD testing both in office and in late night mobile shifts;
- Personally recruit, enroll, and provide risk reduction counseling to HIV+ men;
- Personally link into care clients testing reactive or presenting as out of care;
- Participate in other agency programs and committees that serve the community.

MIAMI TEST COUNSELOR AND COMMUNITY OUTREACH WORKER

- Perform HIV and STD testing both in office and in late night mobile shifts;
- Perform online and in-person outreach to gay Latinos and to other gay/bisexual men in Miami-Dade who are living with HIV;
- Distribute materials to community partners, and establish new partnerships.

Latinos Salud is Florida's only gay, minority-based HIV agency. With locations in Miami-Dade and Broward County, Latinos Salud seeks to reduce the burden of communicable diseases, using a community engagement model.

The successful candidate will have experience working with, or volunteering in programs that serve gay men, especially gay Latinos, especially any work that involved counseling, coaching, or guiding clients toward behavioral changes.

Must be fully bilingual (Spanish and English). Experience navigating systems of HIV care and Ryan White programs is desirable. Candidates who have completed the Florida 500 / 501 HIV testing certification preferred. A college degree is preferred (for the Broward Counseling Lead position, in social work or case management preferred). Must have own transportation, and be willing to work a flexible schedule.
