


Florida Science Training and Research Fellowship Program (F-STAR)

June 3 - July 27, 2018



F-STAR is a multi-year academic and social enrichment program for motivated students who are preparing for a career in medicine. This program provides support and services to students throughout their undergraduate experience. We are seeking rising college sophomores to participate in the F-STAR Fellowship Program.

Program Eligibility :

- ◆ Interest in attending medical school
- ◆ 3.0 overall GPA
- ◆ Completed two semesters of college
- ◆ Has less than 35 college credits
- ◆ Fulltime attendance by
- ◆ June 3-July 27th, 2018
- ◆ Have taken the SAT and/or ACT exams
- ◆ Ability to bring a laptop
- ◆ U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident
- ◆ At least 18 years of age by June 2018
- ◆ Complete application including two Recommendation Forms (one from a science professor)

Program Activities:

- ◆ Provide students with research training
- ◆ Expose students to health issues related to health disparities
- ◆ Provide clinical experiences in diverse settings
- ◆ Bi-monthly webinars and seminars
- ◆ MCAT preparation
- ◆ Medical school application preparation
- ◆ Academic advisement
- ◆ Coaching and wellness support
