2018 HONOREE: EAMONN COGHLAN

Former Senator and World Athletics Champion Eamonn Coghlan is one of the Founding Fathers of the Children's Medical Research Foundation and has been involved with the organization since the early 1980's.

Known as 'Chairman of the Boards' for his unprecedented successes on the American indoor athletics circuit, he won the Wanamaker Mile a record seven times in Madison Square Garden. Eamonn broke the world record for the indoor mile on three occasions and held this record for 18 years.

In 1983 he became the first person to run under 3 min 50 sec for the mile in 3:49.78. Later in the summer, he became the first Irish person to win the World Athletics Championship title over 5,000 metres in Helsinki, Finland.

That victory was one of the greatest moments in Irish sport. Eamonn is a three time Olympian and agonizingly finished 4th twice – the 1500m in Montreal 1976 and the 5000m in Moscow 1980.



On February 20th, 1994 at his last ever race, he became the first person in the World over 40 years old to run a sub 4 minute mile in a time of 3:58:17 in Boston, a feat which will arguably go down as one of his most historic.

Eamonn served five years 2011-2016 in the Irish Government having being nominated to the Senate by Taoiseach Enda Kenny TD.

Last year he received a Fellowship to the Royal College of Physicians in Ireland for his work in Physical Education.

He won an IFTA for his role in athletics documentary featuring Irish Brother and Kenyan athlete David Rudisha, "Man on a Mission". His autobiography, "Chairman of the Boards, Master of the Mile", was published in 2008.
