This workshop is designed to introduce public and private businesses to cyber resilience concepts and to build capability and capacity across key performance areas related to cyber security, IT operations, and business continuity within critical services. The workshop is geared toward executive and operations management within critical infrastructure sectors (public and private) and will result in tangible, useful take-away information related to risk-based decision-making and security planning for critical IT services underpinning core operations.

Participants will be engaged in structured activities, via drills and scenarios, and introduced to concepts through direct discussion. Built-in activities, supported by guidelines and templates help to examine capability building in operational resilience practices and go well beyond discussions centered exclusively on IT security controls & countermeasures.
