**NOTES:**

1. The Tournament is open to all full Club members.
2. All Entrants should be graded. Entries from non-session or ungraded members will only be accepted at the discretion of the committee and, if accepted, placed in an appropriate grade.
3. Competitors are responsible for ascertaining the times of their first games of each draw, which will be posted on the notice boards approximately 5 days prior to the start of the tournament.
4. **We have introduced a new system for those entering graded Doubles events (see Tournament Rule 3).**

## Tournament Rules

1. The qualifying date for graded entry is 1<sup>st</sup> February 2017. Whatever grade you hold on that date is the graded event that you can enter. Anyone upgraded prior to that date must play in the new higher grade. Anyone upgraded since that date may play in his or her old lower grade. Anyone joining the club or receiving their first playing grade since 1<sup>st</sup> February will play in the grade they have been given. D Beginners are encouraged to enter the C draw unless they are given a higher grade by the coaches.
2. Veterans events will be handicapped according to age and grade in pairs entered for each event. Members who enter Veterans events may make a request to compete in a lower age group, but the Committee will agree to this only if they deem it to be in the tournament's best interests. Please Note: The Veterans Singles event will NOT be handicapped. Qualification date for the veterans' age groups will be 1st February 2017. Veterans may also enter graded tournaments.
3. **Members may enter the singles event of their own grade, and may also elect to enter the singles event of a higher grade. In doubles events members may play in their own grade with a partner of the same grade, and may also elect to enter the doubles event of a higher grade. In the higher grade event they may play with a partner from the same grade or a partner from the higher grade. There will be no qualifiers from one grade to the next/higher grade in any of the graded events.**
4. Published events will only take place if there are a sufficient number of entries. If there are fewer than 4 entries for an event (4 players for singles, 4 pairs for doubles) the committee may try to combine them with another event, probably a higher grade or, in the case of veterans, a lower age group. The committee will endeavour to run the early stages of all events on a round-robin basis, proceeding to knock-out stages for later rounds; however, in the event of a poor level of entries some events may be run on a round-robin basis with the two most successful players proceeding to the event final.
5. Applicants should enter all their events on one entry form if possible. Entries will not be accepted unless money is paid at the time the entries are submitted. Entries for Doubles events are only valid when both players in a partnership have submitted an entry and paid the full fee prior to the closing date. If an entrant for a doubles event cannot find a partner they should note this on the entry form; the Committee will endeavour to match them to a partner of the same grade. Entries will not be accepted after the closing date has passed.
6. All competitors must be prepared to play at the time stated for the events entered, including the finals. The entry form contains the dates for each of the events and so all entrants should be available to play on the dates specified for their draw.
7. Players must not enter events if they are unable to finish the tournament and are unable to play on Finals Day. If the committee discovers that a person has entered an event for which they have no intention of playing the final, they will be disqualified from the event before play starts and may be refused entry to further club championships.
8. Any entrant who fails to arrive in reasonable time for an event may be scratched from the tournament and will lose their entry fee.
9. The committee will not re-arrange the dates of any event or final, unless considered to be in the best interests of the tournament by the committee.
10. An approximate playing schedule for Finals Day will be published during the second week of the Club Championships, giving as much notice as possible. Finalists are advised to check the club website and notice board on a regular basis for the up-to-date Finals Day schedule.

Anyone wishing to see the procedures that the committee will use for seeding, draws, and the upholding of these rules should contact the Badminton Committee via Reception.
