Benefits

 - Events include industry-expert speakers and sessions, poster exhibition, Trade Show, and a leadership and Legacy Luncheon. *Entry to the Party + Auction not included.*
 - Note that due to liquor laws, your complimentary membership will be considered "Under 21" regardless of your age and *you may not sample alcohol unless you purchase your own ticket* to the Winegrowers Convention OR the Party + Auction.
- **8-hours of volunteering will earn a FULL student Convention registration.**
- **4-hours of volunteering will earn a ONE-DAY (of your choice) student Convention registration for any Convention day.**
Note: meals are not provided to you during your shift.

Expectations

- Maintain a professional demeanor, punctuality, and willingness to assist attendees with all questions.
- Attire:
 - Black slacks or dress pants (no jeans)
 - Comfortable dress shoes (heels not recommended)
 - Solid-colored business shirt or blouse (black or white preferred; no T-shirts, no midriff/cleavage)
