




Council Meeting Summary

Home Place Happenings

Property Update

Other than keeping up with the grass mowing and trimming (and keeping equipment running), not much has happened over the last month. Wood and supplies are being collected for construction of the shed to be located behind the wooden fence area. Bill Sykes will take the lead on organizing the re-do of the fence around the Garden.

Garden Update

Most of the summer crop dead plant material has have been removed, and beds have been prepared and planted with fall crops of turnip and mustard greens, radishes, carrots and beets.

To date we have produced 1,567 pounds of various veggies which have been donated to the Collierville Food Pantry, Page Robbins Adult Day Center, Trinity Ministries and the St. Mary's Soup Kitchen. We are hopeful for a bountiful crop of fall veggies, which should take total production over 2,000 pounds, up from 1,430 pounds in 2016.

Many thanks to our members who delivered veggies to the agencies, plus those that put together seed tapes for our fall crops. Due to rain and wet conditions, the Chosen Vessel Ministry team Day at the Garden was deferred from Sept 13th to the 20th. We are looking forward to their involvement with us at the Garden.

Of course, we've had many helpers that must be thanked who have worked hard at the Home Place and the Garden, namely Dick, Ed, Pastor Ray, Jill, Bill, Jennifer, Joyce, Christine, the Lankapallis, Christine, and many others. Clearly, all this would not happen without these dedicated and enthusiastic workers. When the opportunity arises, please be sure to take to the time to THANK our Garden Angels!

Chosen Vessel Ministries Women at the Garden

On Wednesday, September 20th , in lieu of our group session, we joined with Epiphany's garden angels to prepare a site and plant the mums. The women also helped pull weeds and harvest vegetables – taking a fair amount home with them. It was especially exciting because this was a totally new experience for two of the women. They were really hesitant at first, but very quickly dived in and thoroughly enjoyed the experience thanks in very large part to the interaction they had with the garden volunteers. 



- **Office Equipment and Supplies** - A small refrigerator, a desk, a filing cabinet that locks, copy paper
