

**Ponte Vedra Artisan Market – December 1 – December 29, 2017**

**Opening reception December 1, 6pm-8pm.**

**Deadline to submit proposal: September 30, 2017.**

The Cultural Center introduces the Ponte Vedra Artisan Market, a pop-up shop exclusively dedicated to promote and sell wearable items designed and crafted by artists. The Cultural Center's curatorial committee will hand select wearable art that is original in concept, design and execution. Special consideration will be given to those artists that live and work in North East Florida. Works selected will include, but not be limited to:

- Handcrafted jewelry
- Handcrafted handbags
- Clothing
- Men's cufflinks, ties, etc
- Handcrafted shoes
- Scarves, hats

1. Number of pieces will depend on type of work submitted and available space.
2. All work must be original in concept, design and execution. Small production studio work will be considered. Work created in a class, workshop, or from a kit or purchased pattern is not eligible.
3. All work must be for sale.
4. Works priced below \$100 are highly recommended for optimal sales.
5. No substitutions for accepted artwork will be allowed. All work must remain on display until sold or until the end of the event.
6. Submitted images may be used for marketing and promotional purposes directly related to this exhibition by CCPVB. Copyright and all other rights remain that of the artist.
7. All accepted entries must be received ready to install or with limited assembly. Any mannequins for wearable art, hanging rods, armatures or other special installation equipment and/or instructions must be provided by artist. It is strongly suggested that jewelry cases have a lock and key.
8. Each accepted work must arrive with labeling (artist name, title, media) and the completed consignment form securely attached to the piece or on the hanging device.
9. CCPVB reserves the right to reject work that is not represented accurately in the submitted images and description. Works that arrived damaged, are poorly constructed, poorly presented or not up to the specified hanging standards will be returned to the artist.
10. CCPVB will handle sales transactions and will ship work to buyer if needed. Shipment of all sold objects will be paid by the purchaser.
11. Purchasers will take work at time of sale. Artist will be responsible for picking up unsold work on designated date after Dec. 29, 2017.
12. There is a 40% commission on sales and 60% goes to the artist. The price of a piece may not be changed after acceptance into the market.
13. Payments to the artist for all sold pieces will be within 30 business days after the closing date of the market. It is the artist's responsibility to contact CCPVB Gallery Manager with the correct mailing address for the check, if different from the agreement.
