The countdown's on! This year's Early Childhood Celebration is April 18, 2017. With 100 days to go, Child Care Aware of New Hampshire is offering to cover the cost of 100 Credentials! This offer includes the \$25 cost of an initial credentialing application fee or the \$10 renewal fee for those re-applying for their Early Childhood Credential. The criteria for this year's challenge is outlined below:

- Receive phone or on-site technical assistance and consultation from a Training and TA Specialist at Child Care Aware of New Hampshire to update your NH Professional Registry profile and apply for your early childhood credential;
- Submit your completed credential application either online or by mail for an Early Childhood Credential through the NH Early Childhood Professional Development System postmarked by March 15, 2017; and
- Attend and receive your Early Childhood Credential at the ECE Celebration on April 18, 2017.
