



Education, Wellness and Justice: A Framework for Understanding Supported Education

The objective of this half day training is to provide a foundational understanding of the field of Supported Education, with a unique focus on students who have histories of both mental health challenges and incarceration/justice system involvement. The training aims to cover both conceptual topics and practical, applied techniques and strategies the trainees can employ at their worksites. During the training, we will cover the history and development of the field in NYC, the current landscape of Medicaid reimbursable services, and the fundamental concepts essential to Supported Education. Following this, the training will cover topics related to the target population, and practical, applied supports provided by a Supported Education program, with a special focus on students in the reentry process.
