Effective Prayer Is...

Not about us.

Whether Elijah prayed for drought, for fire, or for rain, his prayer was all about bringing God glory and bringing about His purposes. God's answer didn't depend on *who* was praying, God had purposed to bring glory to Himself and to bring the people to repentance. He gave Elijah the assignment of praying His purposes into reality.

So it is the same with us. We may think we are too insignificant to pray great things, even if God puts them on our hearts, but that kind of thinking makes prayer about us—and not about Him.

Grounded in God's will.

Much of our prayer—for ourselves or for others—is grounded in *our* will. We pray for an end to the trial we're facing, for a job offer to come through, or for a friend to be healed. Our prayers focus on specific, temporal results rather than God's overarching purposes. Of course, God wants and even commands us to ask, seek, and knock to bring our needs to Him, but it is easy for needs-based prayer to focus on *our* will rather than *God's*.
