Cramer Street Storm Sewer Improvement Project **to begin** ***Monday, August 28, 2017***

Wood Sewer of New London, Wisconsin, under contract by the Village, is scheduled to begin the Cramer Street Storm Sewer Improvement Project, located between Glendale Avenue and Wilshire Road on Monday, August 28, 2017, weather permitting. This project will include the installation of an additional parallel storm sewer system, individual property owner sump drain line connections, spot sanitary sewer main repair, lead water service replacement, minor watermain system improvements, spot curb and sidewalk repairs and roadway resurfacing. The anticipated project completion date is early November, 2017. There will be no assessment to property owners related to this work, other than any private water service work that a property owner elects to be completed.

Cramer Street will be closed to through traffic to permit safe construction operations. However, access will be maintained for those residents adjacent to the project limits throughout most of the project. Overnight on-street parking passes have been previously distributed. Contact the Village if you desire any additional overnight on-street parking passes. Notice will be given to residents a minimum of 24 hours prior to any driveway access restrictions or non-emergency utility interruptions.

Available work hours for this project will be Monday through Saturday 7:00am to 7:00pm, with no work allowed on Sundays. Work operations will be suspended from Friday, September 1st at 5:00pm until Tuesday, September 5th at 7:00am in observance of the Labor Day holiday.

Due to safety concerns, there will be no on-street parking allowed during the construction work day throughout the duration of the project. The Village asks that you drive at a reduced speed while in the construction zone and be aware of the construction activity. The Village will maintain garbage, recycling, brush and yard waste collection on your regularly scheduled day with USPS mail service continuing. Village staff understands how disruptive this work will be to all affected residents and appreciates your patience during the duration of the project.
