## Event Description:

As the very fabric of our community, our region's banks and accounting firms continue to lead the way, building stronger and healthier communities. ## Who is the Cincinnati Community ToolBank?

The Cincinnati Community ToolBank is a nonprofit organization with a goal of ending tool scarcity for America's volunteers. We lend tools to local charitable and community organizations to empower their volunteers to complete larger and more frequent projects that can increase their impact on the community. The Cincinnati Community ToolBank also enables these organizations to save funds that can be utilized to support their own missions.

## Why should you be involved in this event?
