## **Event Description:**

As the very fabric of our community, our region's contractors have continually led the path to building both infrastructure and socially stronger and healthier communities. In keeping with this philanthropic spirit, The Cincinnati Community ToolBank is hosting Greater Cincinnati's 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual "Building on Our Community" on **September 16, 2017**. Building on Our Community is a 1-day, hands-on volunteering event, with local contractors and their employees assisting selected local non-profit organizations. This event will help inspire others to volunteer in our community to make it a better place to live, work, and play.

## **Who is the Cincinnati Community ToolBank?**

The Cincinnati Community ToolBank is a nonprofit organization with a goal of ending tool scarcity for America's volunteers. We lend tools to local charitable and community organizations to empower their volunteers to complete larger and more frequent projects that can increase their impact on the community. The Cincinnati Community ToolBank also enables these organizations to save funds that can be utilized to support their own missions.

## **Why should you be involved in this event?**

- **Relationship Building:** Each contractor and their employees will have the opportunity to cultivating deeper relationships, getting to know each other a little better while working side-by-side on a community project helping to improve our community.
- **Team Building:** Each volunteer will work collaboratively during a hands-on volunteering event that will foster team building and strengthen their internal leadership.
- **Community Building:** Participating contractors will also have the option to volunteer at their preferred charitable organization that is near and dear to their philanthropic giving strategies.
- **Public Relations:** We will be partnering with local media outlets to get significant coverage of the event. The volunteer event, including an appreciation after-party, will be positioned and messaged as the local contractors are collectively thanking the community in which they work and live. The event will also highlight the contractors commitment and investment in the communities.
