Thanks to funding from MEF donations, the library plays a central role on the JM campus. Throughout the day students come in to work on group projects and assignments, to learn about library resources with their classes or to find a comfortable space to read and study. The library's resources include sets of textbooks, Chromebooks, and desktop computers available for use by students working in the library, Monday – Thursday, 8:00 – 4:00. Even during lunch period every seat is taken!
