IGNITE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE

The total three year Ignite Campaign budget is \$5,084,493. The 2018 budget is \$1,300,000. Of that, \$670,000 is for debt reduction, \$300,000 is for outreach and \$330,000 is for maintenance and improvements.

To date, we have cut our debt in half from \$2.5M to \$1.25M. We repainted the church exterior, upgraded audio visual equipment in the Sanctuary and Great Hall, and conducted boiler repairs.

Intentional engagement with the community has resulted in early plans to provide quality day care, food for those with inadequate supply, Spanish language Bible study and the continuation of a successful mentoring program. Transportation and unemployment are issues are also being addressed.
