

MaineHealth ACO Strategic Priorities

After a comprehensive process that included stakeholder interviews and many hours of facilitated discussion among board members and the management team, the MaineHealth ACO has completed a three-year strategic plan that defines a clear path toward becoming a nationally recognized network of providers delivering high-quality, affordable care.

The five-month planning process began with an environmental assessment to understand the current state of the organization. A risk readiness assessment, program review and scenario planning followed, along with the development of a new mission and vision. As the process wrapped up, five areas of the ACO's work emerged as strategic priorities for future success:

- Value Based Contracting
- Data Analytics
- Cost and Quality Performance
- Network Engagement and Accountability
- ACO Workforce Engagement and Development
