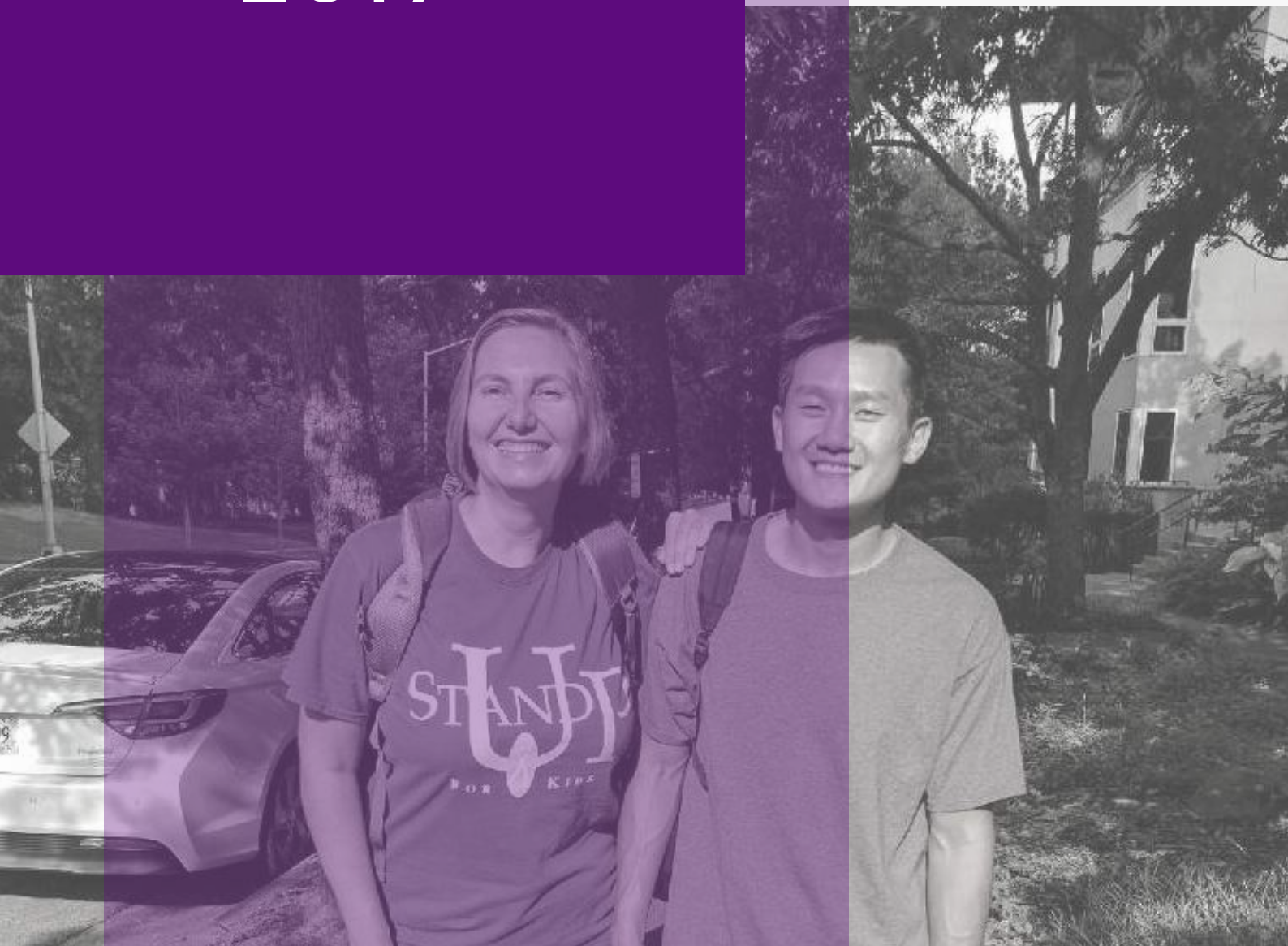

Our dedicated volunteers make StandUp For Kids - Atlanta happen.

Apart from 2 grant-funded full-time employees, volunteers remain the driving force of our local StandUp Chapter. This year, **97** caring adults lent their time and energy empowering homeless and at-risk youth in and around the Metro Atlanta area as school-based mentors and street outreach counselors.

We also introduced new online resources to support our volunteers in furthering StandUp's mission. The new online Volunteer Toolkit and Online Resource Guide are convenient tools volunteers can access to enhance their knowledge base and better serve vulnerable and exploited youth.

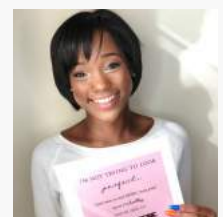
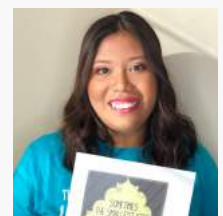

STREET OUTREACH PROGRAM

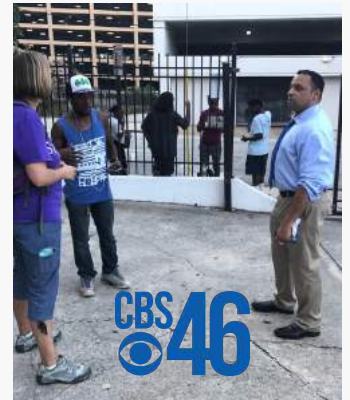
512 incidences of support provided to street dependent and at-risk youth

Our volunteers hit the streets **year round** every Monday and Wednesday evening to identify and befriend homeless and at-risk youth 24 years of age and under on the streets of Atlanta.

Volunteers provide resources, toiletries, snack packs, and harm reduction counseling to address the risks associated with street life.
