

Preston Pierce will show the progression of suffrage from the early 1800s to the adoption of the 19th Amendment.

The program finishes with the successful work engineered by Carrie Chapman Catt after 1915. Susan B. Anthony died in 1906, it was her designated successor, Catt, who got the amendment approved.

Catt represented a new generation of suffragists whose tactics were quite unlike what began in 1848 in Seneca Fall.
