STATE ROUTE 18 (ARCTIC CIRCLE) WINTER PREP WORK BEGINS

SAN BERNARDINO - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) District 8, will once again start day time full closures on State Route 18 (SR-18) in the “Arctic Circle” on Monday, October 2 to complete routine maintenance operations to prepare the route for winter months.

SR 18 will be completely closed between Snow Valley Mountain Resort and Big Bear Dam, Monday through Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. from October 2 through October 26.

Some of the operations that will be completed are slope scaling, turnout clearance, drain cleaning, sign repair and replacement, guardrail repair and other related work.

Motorists are advised to use SR-38 as an alternate route to and from the Big Bear/Fawnskin area.
