A NATURE MYSTIC'S GUIDE TO ASCENSION—Weekend #1



Dates: May 25-27

This weekend is an initiation into the medicine ways of the Peruvian Andes and the transformative arts of the Katari tradition of cross-cultural shamanism.

In the Inkan sacred tradition Q'enti, "The Hummingbird" symbolizes the

way of the Nature Mystic, and the ability to bridge the gap between the sacred and mundane. Through sacred sound and ceremony, you will learn to engage in the dynamic of living energy.

By connecting to the upper-world, you learn to cleanse yourself of the heavy energies that lead to conflict

and illness. Attendees learn to step into infinity, and create sacred space. This is the heart of our ceremonies, where you will bridge the gap between the spiritual and mundane worlds, and learn to be in healing service to the Earth Mother and fellow creation.

MINI APPRENTICESHIP—WEEKENDS #1 & #2 ONLY

Option 1 – Pay Early (\$580 for first two Weekend sessions; must be paid in full prior to start of Weekend #1)

Option 2 – Pay as You Go (\$350 per Weekend #1 & #2; total \$700) Each payment is due in full 7 days before the start each Weekend session.

FULL APPRENTICESHIP—WEEKENDS #1 THROUGH #7

Option 1 – Pay Early (\$1,975 entire program) Pay in full, before the start of Weekend #1.

Option 2 – Deposits and Payments (\$325 each Weekend; total is \$2,275)
A \$100 deposit due before each Weekend; then remaining \$225 to be paid 7 days before scheduled Weekend.

The Great Initiation—Weekend #2

Prerequisite: Attendance in prior weekend #1 program. You may combine both weekends #1 and #2 for a mini-apprenticeship.

DATES: June 22-24

You undergo the rites of the Hatun Karpay, or “Great Initiation”, as passed to Zane by his teacher, Juan Nunenz del Prado. This is the Initiation of the Kurak Akulleq, or 4th level Andean Priesthood. The Hatun Karpay opens you to direct intimate contact with the Divine. In the series of beautifully moving rituals and exercise, you begin the process of re-



connecting yourself to the sacred energy of the earth. You will learn to recognize that you have a strong seed within yourself, which holds your potential and dreams.

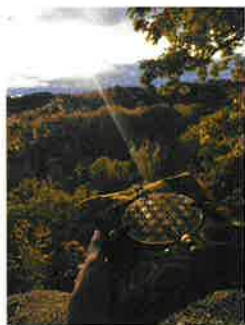
Attendees will physically travel to local, natural sites that hold sacred energy to help connect with the three worlds. With the help of mother nature, you heal the wounds of your personal past, invoke/cleanse the energy of your parents, starting the process of ancestral healing and awakening the spiritual gifts of your family lines. The Hatun Karpay creates the energy necessary to germinate and flower your seed of potential.

Time this weekend will be used to rediscover your potential, and find new ways to understand and express who you are, and what you came here to do.

Misa and Advanced Healing Arts—Weekend #3

Prerequisites: You will need a personal sacred Mesa cloth for this weekend.

DATES: July 27-29



Building upon the previous two weekends, you will dive deeper into the Shamanic worlds of spiritual healing. During this weekend, attendees will apprentice the sacred center of

the Katari Altar Maestro. In the center, we build the Kintu Misa, a power-pack that represents your heart’s fire. The Kintu Misa serves as the Axis Mundi, bridging the three worlds and organizing the flows of spiritual and cosmological energies for your highest good and healing. The mystery teachings of the Kintu Misa facilitate a deepening of connection with nature, spirit and sacred places; becoming an indispensable tool for the service and healing of others.

You will learn to connect to your Ch’aska Kuna, or “Guiding Stars”. This is one of the most important tasks following the

Andean path. Your guiding stars represents your highest potential, spiritual gifts, and talents. Through group work, attendees will define their own personal power and learn to express it using Rima, “The Power of True Speech”. You will structure your Misa according to your personal power, and learn to close it using an Andean folding method. You will learn the ceremonial uses of the Misa, and advanced ways to use the mesa in healing.



The Art of Personal Power—Weekend #4

DATES: August 10-12

The Puma represents the power of Kay Pacha, “This World”, and its connection to the Ukhu Pacha, “Lower World”. This intensive weekend attends to the real work of spiritual adulthood, the eradication of fear and fear-based behaviors. Stepping through the shadowy realms of our inner world, you learn to navigate, “The Seven Powers of The Unconscious”.

During this weekend, attendees will apprentice the wisdom transmissions of the Chaupi teachings; the traditional bridge between the mystical and magical sides of the path. Through the opening of a series of perceptive eyes on the body, you will learn the arts of the Chunpi Paqo. These arts teach you to work with lifetime and encrusted hucha and a powerful practice of Soul Retrieval Andean style. The Chunpi Paqo is considered a special

skill. According to Q’ero stories, when none of the indigenous healers were able to restore health to a sick person, then a Chunpi Paqo was summoned to perform his energy-belt rituals and the person was healed. Through a series of rites, attendees will facilitate “The Sacred Couple” which is a blending of your inner masculine and feminine selves to harmonize more deeply with nature and opening the heart of your community.

Speaking with the Voice of Mountains—Weekend #5

DATES: September 7-9

You will apprentice the skills leading to mastery in your own unique medicine way. This final step in the building of the Monqo Wasi, “Eternal Inner Temple”. This inner work is the path of the Amaru, or “Serpent”, symbolizing your



connection to the lower world, our ancestors, intuition, and impulses. You will gain insight into the eight fields of consciousness and your real capabilities.

This is the power of The Qawaq, or “Visionary”; the skill to transcend ordinary awareness and discern the quality of energy exchanges, understanding how it contributes to creating the conditions of your life.

You will deepen your relationships with your allies: animals, people, and personal guides, who lend their

energy to enhance your ability to see, speak, feel, move and behave authentically. You will learn to use the “Sacred Sight” and awaken the power of the “Oracle”. You will strengthen the Seven Powers culminating in the ultimate act of personal power: the power to manifest your own reality and healing.

Death, Dying & Beyond—Weekend #6

DATES: September 28-30

During this weekend, you will learn how to:

- ♦ aid loved ones on their final journey,
- ♦ care for those left behind,
- ♦ assist with the grieving process, and the unique illnesses caused by losing a loved one.

You will learn about various cultural views on death including Western, Tibetan, Egyptian, Amazonian, and Andean,

and about the wisdom contained in the Tibetan and Egyptian Books of the Dead, and how to administer the death rites to a dying person.

You shall experience the Aya Despacho, and shamanic small death. Small death is a special type of ceremonial journey used by medicine people to

experience the disorienting effects of dying and to map the journey into the afterlife.



Misa: Living the Ceremony—Weekend #7



DATES: October 26-28

During this final weekend, you will learn

to host the quintessential ceremony of the Katari Paqo Tradition; “The Spiritual Misa”. A Misa (or “Mass”), is the ceremonial embodiment of the Three Virtues; Faith, Hope and Charity. A place where you will learn and grow spiritually. Attendees will establish your connection to the spirits and forces of nature. A Misa is about community, not just of humans, but of spirits and nature beings. People attend Misas for many reasons; to receive guidance in life, for instruction in the use

and development of spiritual gifts, or spiritual healing. During a Misa, a delicate web is woven between the seen and unseen worlds, between human, spirit, and nature. Through this web, we all become one, part of the flow of life giving energy.
