REV. DR. JUAN GONZALEZ

Rev. Juan A. Gonzalez' whole life is dedicated to serving the Lord Jesus Christ. As a servant leader, he is committed to equipping individuals and communities to empower themselves, creating opportunities through holistic approaches that result in positive transformation and a better quality of life. He is about sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ and expanding the kingdom of God.

He graduated with degrees from the University of Buffalo, New York (1979) and Concordia Lutheran Theological Seminary, St. Catherine's, Ontario, Canada (1988). He served from 1985 to the present as a parish pastor in LCMS Congregations in Buffalo, New York; Miami, Florida; Lorain, Ohio; Brooklyn, New York; and Lehigh Acres, Florida. He also served as an associate pastor at Hope, Bonita Springs, and completed a short-term mission in both Sterling & Cooper Landing in the Kenai Peninsula, Alaska. On October 31, 2015 he was installed as the newly called Pastor of Beautiful Savior Lutheran Church, Lehigh Acres, Florida, where he is presently starting a new mission in the Lehigh Acres community. The aim is to reach the next generation with the Gospel.

He is the former Executive Director of Lutheran Services New York Alliance (LSNYA); he directed the *LSNYA Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) Program*; served as National Consultant in Leadership training for the LCMS World Relief & Human Care' National Housing Support Corporation; served on the LCMS Board for International Missions (2010-2016); served on the LCMS Board for Districts & Congregational Services (2004-2010); and the LCMS Board for Human Care Ministries (1994-2004).

Both he and his wife of 39 years, Eva, presently worship, serve and live in the Fort Myers area since early 2011. They have three adult children and three grandchildren.
