How to volunteer for a Colorado *FIRST LEGO League* Competition:



- Register as a volunteer with *FIRST* – <http://firstinspires.org>
- Choose “Sign Up” if you a new volunteer or “Login” if you are a returning volunteer
- Choose “Volunteer Registration” and then “Volunteer at an Event” and then choose FLL.
- Find the event you want to volunteer for and then choose the role(s) you are interested in and your availability. We especially need judges – this doesn’t require special skills and there is online training in advance of event.
- You will hear from a volunteer coordinator confirming your assignment close to the date of the event you volunteered for.
