STATE AID FOR EDUCATION SINCE FY 2012

In the FY 2019 Executive Budget Briefing Book

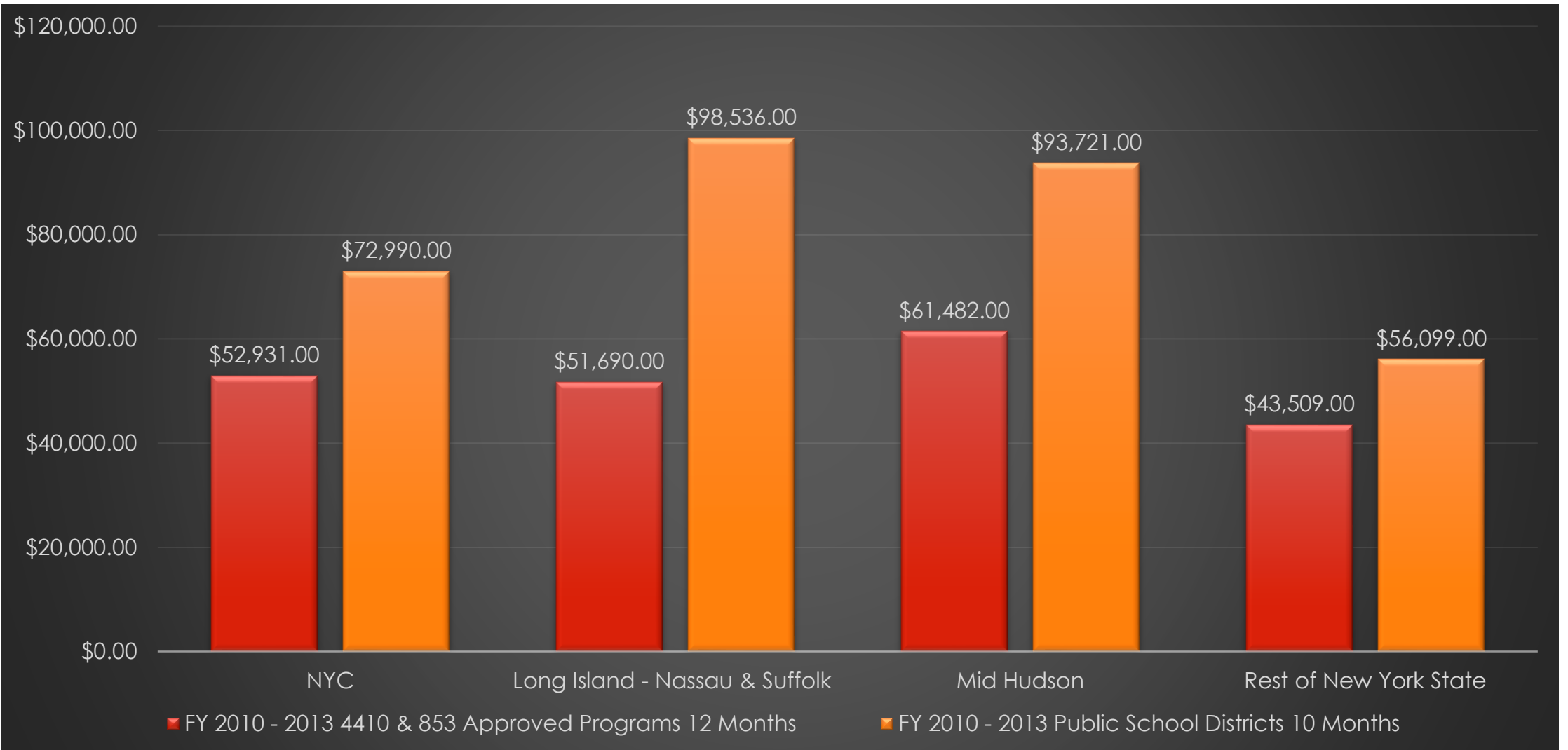
- It states “The FY 2019 Executive Budget reflects the Governor’s strong commitment to education” This represents a cumulative 35 percent increase in School Aid since FY 2012.

During that same time period:

- 853 programs have received an **18.8%**
- 4410 programs have received a **6%** increase in tuition

TURNOVER RATES – 4410 AND 853 PROGRAMS

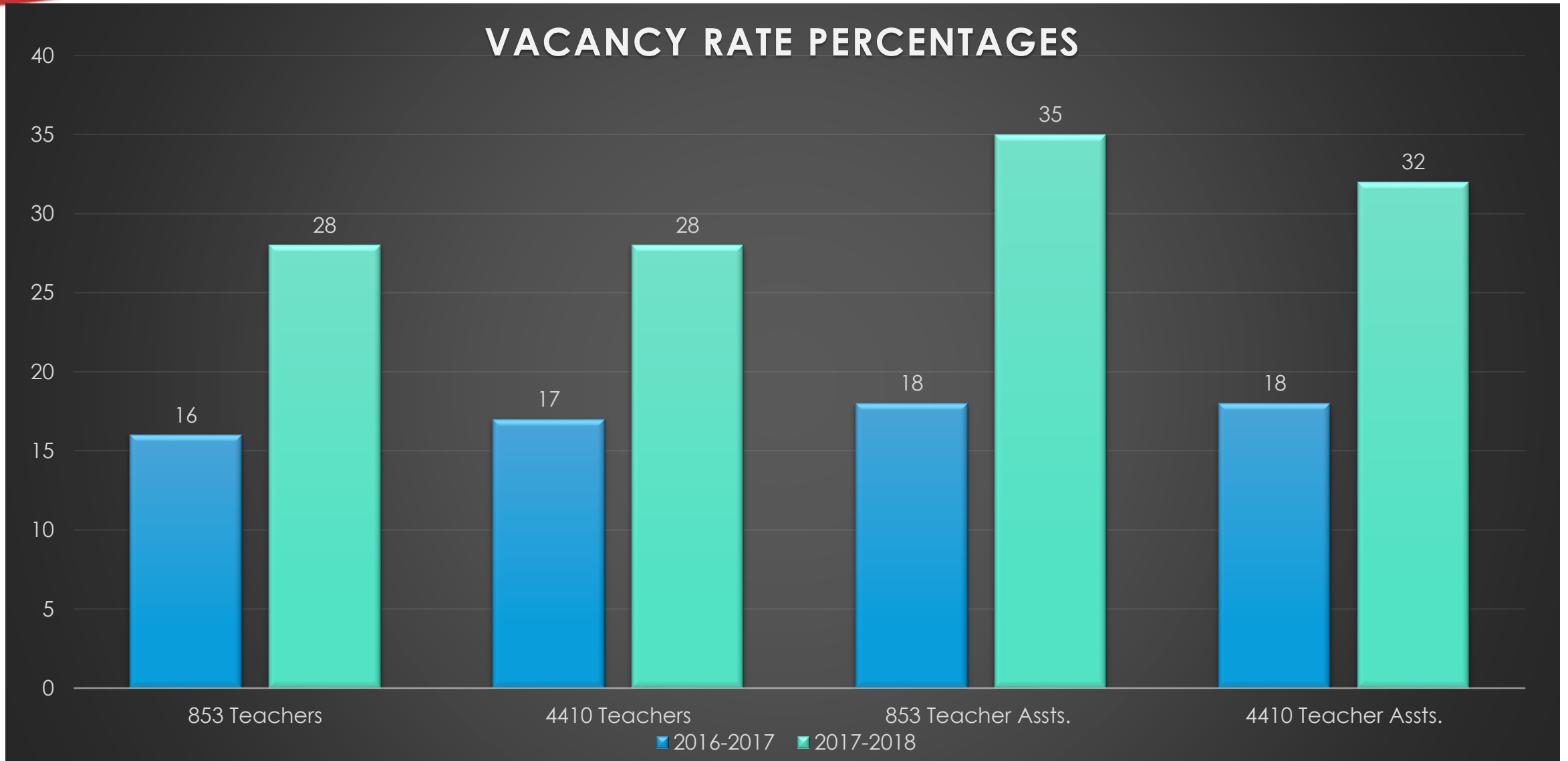
Certified Teachers

- **853 State Approved Non-Public Schools - Turnover Rate was 31%**
- Four - 853 schools had turnover rates above 40%
- **4410 Preschool Special Education Programs – Turnover Rate was 26%**
- Three - 4410 programs had turnover rate over 50%. All three programs lost half their teachers in less than one year

Certified Teacher Assistants

- **853 State Approved Non-Public Schools - Turnover Rate was 25%**
- One - 853 school lost 11 of their 14 teacher assistants in less than one year.
- **4410 Preschool Special Education Programs – Turnover rate was 23%**
- Three - 4410 programs had a teacher assistant turnover rate above 40%. One preschool program lost 17 of their 28 teacher assistants in less than one year.

PRESCHOOL SPECIAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS CLOSING ACROSS NEW YORK STATE AT AN ALARMING RATE

- 61 Preschool Special Education Programs have closed state-wide in the past 3 ½ years. 31 of the special education preschool program closures were in New York City.
- Regional Need Request for NYC– more than 7 Preschool Special Educational Seats

Breakdown of Special Class Seats Needed by Borough

- Brooklyn – 158
- Bronx – 116
- Queens -254
- Manhattan – 84
- Staten Island – 116
- 2 more preschool programs have announced closure since this request
