

# 2017 Camping FAQ

## Mountain Home Country Music Festival

### July 28 to 30, 2017

#### **Where is this Place!!**

That is a very good question! The Mountain Home Country Music Festival is located 35.5 miles northeast of Mt. Home. Here are directions:

Coming from the West or East - From I-15, take Hwy 20 E for 35.5 miles. Turn left onto Forest 61. Follow the continual signage and flaggers to the venue check in.

Coming from the South - From Hwy 46 N, turn right onto Hwy 20. Head west approximately 25 miles. Turn right not Forest 61 Follow the continual signage and flaggers to the venue check in.

\*\*If you put the following address into Google Maps, you will get close to the main entrance - just follow the signs! 6155 Forest 61 Hill City, ID 83337

**When Can I Come?** Campers can start checking in as early as Thursday, July 27th at noon. Check out is Monday, July 31st by noon. If you are coming late on Thursday or early on Friday, or you need to leave early on Sunday, no problem. All campsites are easy to access.

#### **Parking**

Your campsite comes with 1 camping vehicle parking pass. If you need additional parking passes, please contact Megan at Bish's RV at 208-313-4303 or [megan.walker@bishs.com](mailto:megan.walker@bishs.com). There is a limit of 2 extra passes per campsite. Megan will also have extras up in Mt. Home with her.

#### **Campfires**

NO! NO! NO! We are in the middle of grassland with a HUGE potential for fire. No campfires or open flames allowed. Propane grills that sit off the ground are only allowed. Grill MUST be 30-32" high off the ground. Small propane grills that sit on the ground are not allowed unless you placed it on a table.

#### **People per Campsite**

The Festival is allowing 6 people per campsite. Each person staying within your campsite must have a wristband for the Festival. Children 6 years and younger allowed in the general admission area for free. Children 7 to 11 must have a ticket. Children under 18 must have an adult or parent with them. Children age 2 and up must have a full-priced ticket if seating in the PGA or VIP areas.

#### **Amenities**

RV Tanks - There are no hook ups for your RV. This is dry camping! A dumping service will be available to clean your tanks out throughout the weekend. Information for this service will be provided closer to the event.

Fresh Water - Make sure to bring enough fresh water to last you for the entire weekend. BUT, we understand that sometimes that's not possible. If you need your RV tank or a water container filled, a service will be available up at the Festival. Information for this service will be provided closer to the event.

Portable Toilets - Bish's RV rents portable toilets for our exclusive camping area. They will be conveniently placed throughout the campground for you.

Showers - There are shower facilities located on-site. Information for this amenity will be provided closer to the event.

Trash - Complimentary trash pickup is available Friday through Sunday, between 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Simply place your bagged trash at the corner of your campsite and it will be picked up; no appointment is necessary. If you are leaving the grounds after 5 p.m. on Sunday, take it with you please; **DO NOT** leave it on site.

### **Generators**

Generators are allowed from 9 a.m. to midnight every day. Just remember to bring extra fuel!

### **Animals**

Animals are allowed in the campground areas but not the music venue (except Certified Service Animals). If you are bringing your pet, please do not leave them in your RV or tent during the concerts. It's too hot and you will be kicked out of the Festival. Please bring a chain or kennel to lock them up outside while you're at the concerts.

### **Visitors**

If you have friends that will be at the Festival but staying at a different campsite, they are welcome to come visit you at the Bish's RV Campground. Visitors outside the Festival will not be permitted onto the grounds unless they have a wristband to the concert and a vehicle parking pass.

### **Off-Road Vehicles**

No off-road vehicles (ATVs, dune buggies, golf carts, motorcycles/dirt bikes, scooters, Go-Karts, etc) are permitted in the campground. If you bring your toys, be prepared to keep them at your campsite. Electrical wheel chairs are OK.

### **Alcohol**

Here's the big one. No alcohol is permitted outside the licensed venue (meaning the beer gardens inside the concert venue). Sorry, this is Festival rules and policy.

### **Quiet Time**

Elmore County has a Noise Ordinance - quiet after midnight. That means all generators must be shut off by this time and any campsite parties need to come to a murmur. This will be strictly enforced by both the on-site security and Elmore County Deputies. Loud noise can start back up at 9 am every morning.
