Parent Orientation: March 14 at 6 p.m.; Paul Revere Room (Canceled due to Snow)

Meeting Location: Students will meet between 3:45-4:10 in Minuteman's cafeteria where attendance will be taken and then escorted to their classes. The cafeteria is on the first level.

Directions to Cafeteria:

Front Entrance: enter building and take a left to staircase and follow down to cafeteria.

West Entrance (pool side): enter building, go right to the cafeteria.

Snacks: Please send a snack in with your child to eat prior to the start of class in the cafeteria.

Transportation: The bus company and each middle school will receive a list of students riding the bus. Pick-up and Drop-off locations are listed on the bus schedule attached. Be at your bus stop at least 5-10 minutes early so you won't miss your bus.

IMPORTANT: Call Minuteman at (781) 861-7150 if your child will not be using the free transportation provided to our in-district students either for pick-up, drop-off, or both.

For the return trip, busses leave Minuteman High School at 6:25 p.m. and return students to the pick-up locations listed on the attached bus schedule. No other stops can be made.

Parent/Guardian Dropping Off or Picking Up: If you will be picking up or dropping off your child, please contact the school if your child will not be using the free transportation provided to our in-district students.

Students must be dropped off between 3:45-4:05 at either the Front or West Entrances. ***There is only one location for picking your child up at Minuteman.*** Students must be picked up at the West Entrance (pool side) between 6:25 and 6:35. Please be on time.

- ▶ Late arrivers should report to Community Education for a pass. Enter building at Main Entrance and walk straight up two short flights of stairs to Community Education.

Career Explore: Each student will participate in a Career Exploratory component to the program. Structured into each program is a 45 minute workshop where students will assess their interests via the Harrington O'Shea Career-Decision Making System. Students will reflect and learn about a variety of careers they find interesting. Each student will be equipped to share at home Minuteman's career pathways aligned to their interests.

Nurse: A registered nurse will be on duty during class time.

Special Dress/Requirements: The following programs have identified special requests for students participating in these programs.

- ▶ **Trades Programs:** Safety glasses will be provided. Students should dress appropriately and wear closed toed shoes (work boots are preferred but not required), jeans (please no sweatpants), remove hanging jewelry, and have long hair tied back.
- ▶ **Computer Related Classes:** Those enrolled in a class requiring a computer may want to bring in a USB Drive so they can take home their digital projects.
- ▶ **Android App Development:** Students will need access to a Google Account. A Gmail account from their sending district will be sufficient. Any student who does not have a Google account should sign up for one before the first class meeting and be aware of both their **Username** and **Password**.
- ▶ **Culinary Arts Programs:** Paper hats will be provided. Students should dress appropriately and wear closed toed shoes, pants (no shorts or skirts), remove hanging jewelry, and have long hair tied back. Please do not wear your best clothing, if you have an apron bring it if you want.
