This is a three-part series to be held at the [Presbyterian Student Center](#). The purposes of these workshops are to give attendees an opportunity to listen to their brothers and sisters, whose experiences may be different from their own, and also for attendees to consider future actions that may be taken by individuals or by groups. Ultimately, we hope to build bridges and find common ground to further race relations in our community.

**First date:** Monday, January 22, 2018 – Panel presentation: A panel of African-Americans will present their perspectives and experiences. A list of takeaways will be compiled from the panel presentations.

**Second date:** Monday, February 12, 2018 – Panel presentation: A panel of law enforcement officers will present their perspectives as law enforcement officers. A list of takeaways will be compiled from the panel presentations.

**Third date:** Monday, March 26, 2018 – Moderators will lead small group discussions on the list of takeaways compiled at the two previous panel presentations. These discussions may identify actions necessary to move forward within the area of race and law enforcement.

There is no charge for these workshops and reservations are not required but would be helpful in our planning (materials, etc.).
