Several t-shirts and modest shorts

- No strapless or spaghetti straps for girls
- Dark Colored Shirt to wear in the water for girls

Bathing Suit (one-piece for girls if available, no bikinis)

Undergarments

Extra towel for pool/blob

Sunscreen

T-shirts, caps and Christian music are available for purchase in the camp store.
