Join us in a FROG Tradition! Ring in the Christmas and Holiday Season in the charming glow of Charleston, SC's Holiday Festival of Lights!



Enjoy the gracious southern hospitality of one of America's most charming cities as you step back in time in beautiful Charleston, South Carolina.

We'll learn about the city's historic district through a carriage tour of the area. Learn why Charleston is the "Holy City," and see the churchyard where signers of the Constitution and the Declaration of Independence and a former U.S. Vice President lie buried. Stop by Rainbow Row, the largest contiguous group of pre-Revolutionary homes in America. We'll take a cruise on historic Charleston Harbor and stand on the walls where Confederate shells rained down on Fort Sumter to start the American Civil War in April of 1861.



We'll visit tranquil Boone Hall Plantation. Established in 1681, Boone Hall remains a working plantation to this day. The towering live oak canopy over the estate's entry lane provides a gracious welcome to the property. The mansion, gardens, cotton fields, slave quarters, working support buildings, and much more will provide a view of plantation life.

We'll visit Patriot's Point, which guards the city and access to the Ashley and Cooper Rivers. It's now home to the aircraft carrier USS Yorktown, the destroyer USS Laffey, and the submarine USS Clamagore. Patriot's Point houses a Naval and Maritime Museum, the National Medal of Honor Museum, and a 2½ acre "Vietnam Experience Exhibit: A Hero's Welcome Home."



But our focus will be on the Holiday Festival of Lights. The festival comes alive with the spectacle of 3 miles of shimmering Christmas and seasonal displays lighted by nearly 3 million lights! From Santa's Village to the Winter Wonderland; from the carousel to the trains; from the larger than life sand sculpture to the marvelous

displays, we'll enjoy it all. We'll stay right in the middle of the festival at the beautiful James Island County Park Campground, rated one of the best campgrounds in the Southeast.

Along the way we'll enjoy dinner at one of the Southeast's most renowned seafood restaurants. (Non-seafood entrees will also be available.) We'll share another great dinner, meet for continental and hot breakfasts, and enjoy a box lunch picnic.

You'll also have time to explore the area on your own. Stop by Folly Beach and Fishing Pier on the Atlantic Ocean, or just kick back and relax in the park. Enjoy nearly six miles of paved hiking / biking trails, traversing marshes, forests, open spaces, and native wildlife. Take your furry "kid" to the off-leash dog park, or visit the fishing pier overlooking the marsh. (Watch for the dolphins in the creek.)
