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Educators Rising Ohio Student Conduct

Practices and Procedures

The term “student” shall mean any member attending the Educators Rising Ohio State Conference.

- Students shall abide by all conference rules.
- Students shall stay at the approved hotel/motel during the conference.
- Students shall respect and abide by the authority of the Executive Committee, presiding officers, committee chairmen, and advisor or authorized representative of the aforementioned.
- Students shall attend all sessions and activities assigned unless engaged in some specific assignment taking place at the same time.
- Students shall wear acceptable attire to all program activities as specified in the program.
- Students shall not smoke or use tobacco.
- Illegal drugs, tobacco, or alcohol, in any form, shall not be possessed or used by any student. Possession is defined as having on one’s person, in one’s belongings such as in a purse or in luggage, in one’s hotel/motel room, or having knowledge that illegal drugs, tobacco, or alcohol are in one’s hotel/motel room or in another person’s possession.
- Identification badges/nametags shall be worn at all official functions.
- Educators Rising Ohio shall, under no circumstances, approve or condone the use or serving of alcoholic beverages by anyone during official functions. This is in effect from the time the student leaves home until he/she returns home.
- Educators Rising Ohio shall, under no circumstances, approve or condone the use of drugs in any form, except for medical purposes, by anyone at the ERSC. This is in effect from the time the student leaves home until he/she returns home.
- Students shall keep their adult teacher leaders informed of their activities and whereabouts at all times.
- Students shall not use their own cars or ride in cars belonging to others during the conference unless accompanied by an authorized teacher leader.
- Only registered individuals are allowed at conference activities.
- Students shall not patronize public places which would bring reproach to the organization or to themselves.
- Curfew each night shall be **10:30 pm**, or earlier if the teacher leader deems it necessary, and all students shall be in their rooms by curfew.
- Students are expected to stay in their assigned rooms and not in the rooms assigned to other students. Male and female students are not to be in each other’s room unless accompanied by an official conference advisor.
- Students shall conduct themselves in a professional manner.
- Students shall not participate or become involved in any way, in the election process of other *divisions*.
- Students violating or ignoring any of the rules will be subject to removal from the conference at the expense of their parents.

*****Failure to abide by any of the aforementioned Rules of Conduct will result in the student being sent back to their home via their parents (who must come and get them from the conference)**

- B. Chapter membership registration is due by **12/2/2016**. If chapter membership is not paid, students may not participate in competitions.
- C. *Onsite registration is not allowed.*

General Information

- A. Educators Rising Ohio contests are aligned to the national guidelines and rubrics with the exception of a few areas. Educators Rising Ohio will be using the Educators Rising National Competition Guidelines and Rubrics (with some slight changes). Specific guidelines and rules exist for each of the competitions. Please check the aligned competition chart. **(starting on page 14)**
- B. For **the state conference pre-judged competitions**, the top 10 or top 5 entries are invited to participate in the onsite component of their competition at the Educators Rising Ohio state conference. The Teacher Leaders of the top 5 or top 10 qualifying contestants are notified 2-3 weeks prior to the conference.
- C. State Conference is on **March 16 & 17, 2017**, at Ohio Dominican University campus. Competitions will take place on Thursday, March 16, 2017 with possible callbacks on March 17, 2017.
- D. All individual and chapter competitions are open to good standing Educators Rising Ohio chapters.
- E. Each Educators Rising Ohio Chapter **may enter only one student per individual competition OR one chapter team per chapter competition**. If you have more than one student interested in entering a competition, we highly recommend you hold a local chapter competition.
(NOTE: this differs from the National Educators Rising Guidelines)
- F. Students may enter up to total of (2) combined events, but NOT (2) individual events. Example: Students may compete in one chapter and one individual event. Chapter competitions must have (2 – 4) representatives present.

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- G. Competitors are expected to **dress in business-casual attire**. A deduction of points occurs for failure to follow the dress code.
- H. **All video files submitted in advance must be in .mp4 format.**
- I. Results may vary from state to national judging. All judges' decisions are final.
- J. Awards will be given to the top 3 entries in each category. The Top 5 entries are announced at the conference. Certificates are sent electronically to the Teacher Leader following the conference.
- K. **Glitter and Glitter-related Products Policy:**
A no glitter policy is in place for all competitions at the state conference. This includes glitter glue and all products containing glitter. Glitter is allowed on scrapbook pages **only** if the page is enclosed in a plastic sleeve. Failure to comply with competition guidelines will result in immediate disqualification of the entry.
- L. Entrants grant the conference committee the **right to use and publish** conference entries in print, online, or in any other media in connection with this competition without compensation. Failure to complete and return the "Right to Use and Publish" form will disqualify your chapter from all competitions.
- M. A **Student Code of Conduct** is included in your registration. All conference attendees will be held to this Code of Conduct. *Teacher Leaders are responsible to keep all documentation on file.*
- N. **Written permissions for copyrighted material** must be obtained for the rights to display and present media related materials at the conference. All permissions obtained to use copyrighted material must be included with entry submission. (Note: This requirement does apply to music used in videos and other media-related materials. It does not apply to artifacts collected for a project.) Failure to accomplish this will result in disqualification.
