## From the Pastor



Dear Friends,

First, please be assured that I am holding each one of you close through prayer. I carry thoughts of you constantly on my heart throughout the day wondering how everyone is getting along. I miss our in-person chats and updates that come during the week and on Sunday mornings.

We are faced with anxious and uncertain times. Not only are we dealing with COVID-19 but now the violence in our state and nation as the result of George Floyd's passing.

Many of us are COVID weary. Our sense of normalcy has changed. We miss family vacations, gatherings, having favorite businesses open. We miss gathering for worship in our church building. We are still the church. We are still worshipping. We are still in prayer. We still are serving our neighbor.

We are comforted to know that we are not alone. Presently most congregations in our area are not yet gathering for inperson worship. The Councils of Melo and Our Savior's will be meeting on June 9 at 7:00 pm to re-visit next steps. Staff has prepared for whatever decision is made. A letter will be sent out when a change takes place.

We are also faced with the violence in surrounding communities. Be in prayer for our state, our nation, and world. Often our zip code defines who we are and our well-being. We are thankful for the faithful law enforcement in our community.

Know that we in the church are working tirelessly to discover new ways to provide pastoral care, spiritual guidance and meaningful worship opportunities during this time of physical distancing and quarantine. Much will be offered through various types of technology. We will also be using cards, phone calls, postcards and letters.

May God be our peace and strength.

Protect the most vulnerable among us especially all who are sick or in isolation.

Grant wisdom and clarity to healthcare workers.

## Our Savior's Lutheran Church May 2020 Council Meeting Minutes (not yet approved)

The May 19, 2020 OSL Council meeting was called to order at 7:04 pm by Jim Duckstad. Pastor Janet opened with prayer.

**Attending:** Adam Sparby, Jim Duckstad, Tony Johnson (by teleconference), Pastor Janet, Joan Peterson, Amanda Liebersbach. **Absent:** Travis Hanel, Kaitlin Barbosa.

**This month's agenda and last month's meeting minutes**: Jim motioned to approve and Tony seconded. Motion carried.

**Treasurer's Report** given: We received generous gifts in April as well as the \$20,000.00 small business grant from the Federal Government to cover payroll and utilities. Motion made to accept treasurer's report by Tony seconded by Adam. Motion carried.

Pastors' Reports: Pastor Janet has been very busy with on -line services, zoom meetings with the conference, synod, and ministerial. Meals were delivered and the Food shelf was staffed. Regular phone calls, texts, and e-mails are being made. There is 1 funeral, 2 baptisms, and 1 wedding in the wings. Pastor has visited and talked with these families. Pastor is awaiting their decision on dates and times. Pastor has been available to families for urgent and end of life visits. Pastor has sent out the Confirmation packets. Pastor has worked to put together Senior Recognition, Memorial Day, and Pentecost services. All services are being well received. A special thanks to the worship team and to Jim Duckstad for taping the service on Facebook. Pastor is working towards resuming in-person worship. The CDC and MN Health and the Synod produced 13 pages of Guidelines for reopening in-person worship. These have been reviewed and necessary steps have been taken to see that all is in compliance. Pastor has been part of numerous zoom meetings as well as providing guidance in the community. Though ministry has changed it is a very busy time. When a change for in- person occurs a letter will be sent out. Motion made to accept Pastors' reports by Tony, seconded by Adam - Motion carried.

#### **Committee Reports:**

**Stewardship** – Meals delivered and Food Shelf Staffed **Worship and Evangelism** – Altar guild is planned through December, lectors and song leaders are present for on-line worship. Calendar reviewed.

**Education and Youth** – VBS is on hold as are Youth Events. **Youth Leader** – Joan Peterson is staffing the office every Tuesday from 10 to 1 pm. Regular calls are being made to youth and their families.

**Property and Management** – Mowing this summer will be done by the ODC. Flowers planted and cared for by Jana Maruska. A new computer has been ordered for the Pastor's Office as the old computer is not able to do zoom and

other meetings. Motion made to approve committee reports by Jim seconded by Tony – Motion carried.

**Old Business** – Karen Poverud has moved to Mayville. Her last Sunday is May 31. After COVID -19 restrictions are lifted a celebration will be held for her thanking her for being organist for 18 years. A gift will be presented to her on May 31. The screen and projection unit is on hold. A committee for basement tables and chairs is in place. ODC will be mowing church lawn and parsonage this summer.

**New Business** – After considerable discussion it was decided to wait two weeks before starting in-person worship as we have active COVID-19 cases in Warren. We will re-visit this on June 9.

The next special Council meeting is June 9 at 7:00 pm at OSL to discuss in-person worship.

Tony made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Adam seconded. Motion carried.
