Interview for vacant youth director position.

This month's agenda and last month's meeting minutes: Jim made a motion to approve the agenda and previous meeting minutes. Sharon seconded. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: November finances are good. Quarterly worship supplies were purchased. General fund is doing very well.

Pastor Janet's Report: Pr. Janet made 9 hospital visits, 12 homebound visits, 7 member visits and there are two prospective members. No marriages in November, but one baptism. There were two funerals. Bible studies are going well. She continues working with stewardship on a church directory, confirmation classes and Worship and Evangelism Committee. She is helping in planning for the National Youth Gathering. The visitation list was reviewed with Wanda and WELCA.

Audit Committee: Need to find one new person to be appointed by council for 2020 financial record review.

⁴Love is patient; love is kind; love is not envious or boastful or arrogant ⁵or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; ⁶it does not rejoice in wrongdoing, but rejoices in the truth. ⁷It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

⁸Love never ends. But as for prophecies, they will come to an end; as for tongues, they will cease; as for knowledge, it will come to an end. 9For we know only in part, and we prophesy only in part; 10 but when the complete comes, the partial will come to an end. 11When I was a child, I spoke like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child; when I became an adult, I put an end to childish ways. ¹²For now we see in a mirror, dimly, but then we will see face to face. Now I know only in part; then I will know fully, even as I have been fully known. ¹³And now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; and the greatest of these is love.

Those ladies who have been part of the prayer shawl ministry, knitting and crocheting yarn they have donated, are: Mary Jo Chandler, Bev Duckstad, Florence Johnson, Karen Larson, and Jeanie Ulferts. A Beautiful Mosaic ~ Commissioned for the OSL Centennial in 1985 and dedicated to the memory of Bertil Haugen

'On Our Way Rejoicing'

The central figure is the victorious Christ with arms outstretched, both as a reminder of the crucifixion and as a gesture of embracing all of the world. The garments of Christ are a representation of a heavenly cityscape.

The *nativity* described in Luke is depicted amidst the shadow of earth. Mary with the Christ child, the three kings, the sheep—all traditional elements of the Christmas story.

The *ladder* is a symbol of the descent from the cross as well as the ascent of the human condition.

The ruins in the background suggest the fallibility of life on earth (war and destruction) in contrast with the golden city above. The fallen figure on the left serves as a reminder of the Good Samaritan and the Beatitudes (blessed are they...).

The child at right is standing on ground leading to the present and the future and holds a resurrection banner as a symbol of belief and understanding.

The skies are animated and filled with stars and planets, a reminder of our diminutive place in the whole scheme of creation. The dove is also a symbol of creation and a myriad of other concepts including the Holy Spirit,

peace, and the annunciation of Mary.
