Present: Travis Hanel, Jim Duckstad, Kaitlin Barbosa, Amanda Liebersbach and Pr. Janet Warnes. **Absent**: Tony Johnson, Sharon Nelson, Mike Miller.

This month's agenda and last month's meeting minutes: Jim made a motion to approve previous meeting minutes and agenda. Kaitlin seconded. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Amanda presented the treasurer's report, noting general fund is doing well. Funds have been transferred from general fund to individual accounts, which happens twice annually. Reimbursement has been requested from synod for pulpit supply during Pastor Janet's leave. Amanda presented last year financials and 2020 proposed budget. Jim made a motion to give an increase of 0.50 an hour for office secretary. Kaitlin seconded. Motion carried. Kaitlin made a motion to approve the proposed budget. Jim seconded. Motion carried.

Pastor Janet's Report: Pr. Janet made 8 hospital calls, 15 homebound visits. 6 member visits, and there are 2 prospective members. There is one upcoming baptism and two funerals this month. She continues to work with the youth board towards planning for the national youth gathering. The WELCA executive board will be donating \$5000 towards tables and chairs in the basement. A committee has been formed to research options. She continues to work with the Warren Food Shelf, nursing home services. the youth committee, Confirmation and Worship and Evangelism Committee.

Pastor Ron's Report: December visits have been completed with Pr. Janet as he continues to recover from surgery. 42 are on the homebound list.

Kaitlin made a motion to approve the pastors' reports. Jim seconded. Motion carried.

Stewardship: None at this time.

Worship & Evangelism: Souper Bowl of Caring will be February 2. January 26 and February 23 are youth leadership Sundays. Warren Ministerial is planning Lenten services, with OSL hosting March 25.

Education and Youth: Youth made Christmas cookies to sell. Sunday School has started back up and will do Easter program

Property and Management: A space heater will be purchased for the sanctuary. Lightbulbs have been replaced in narthex.

Jim made a motion to approve committee reports. Kaitlin seconded. Motion carried.

Old Business

Projection unit: Projection unit is moving forward as funds were donated to purchase the unit.

Basement table & chairs: A committee has been formed.

Annual Meeting will be January 26.

Audit Committee: Jim made motion to appoint Darrell Rindy, Wayne Spidahl and Phil Thompson to the 2020 audit committee. Kaitlin seconded. Motion carried.




