





Reformation Sunday is October 27th.

Thoughts of being a Christian Lutheran continue to echo in my head.

Here are core Biblical Lutheran Themes:



- □ Justification by grace through faith: "For there is not distinction, since all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God; they are now justified by his grace a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus..." (Romans 3:22-24)
- Law and gospel: Luther said, "The law says, 'do this' and it is never done.
 Grace says, 'believe in this' and everything is already done." (Law convicts; grace frees.)
- □Means of grace: Grace happens when the good news of Jesus is preached; when someone is baptized; and when one receives the Lord's Supper.
- □Theology of the cross: God died on the cross rather than leave us in our brokenness.
- □Saint and sinner: A saint is a forgiven sinner. We are both saint and sinner. Our righteousness depends on God's grace.
- □Vocation: We are all part of the priesthood of all believers in that we teach and pray for one another, and our work/profession is a calling from God of one in faith and for the service of neighbor.
- □ Faith in context: "A Christian is a perfectly free lord of all, subject to none. A Christian is a perfectly dutiful servant of all, subject to all".

Confirmation will begin with orientation in September for grades 7-9. Grades 7 & 8 will help with the OSL Fall Supper.

Mike made a motion to approve the Pastors' reports and Jim seconded. Motion carried.

Committee Reports:

Stewardship: Working on organizing a church directory; will meet in September.

Worship and Evangelism: Altar guild is set through December. Joan will attend a class through Poppler's Music.

Youth and Education: Sunday School theme is "Roar." Teachers are being sought. Vacation Bible School held in June went well.

Property and Management: Sanctuary doors are refinished. Flag poles are up but need to be straightened. West entry stairs are completed. Repairs and maintenance at the parsonage done recently include: interior door from garage repaired, water heater replacement and cleanup, deck stained, landscape work done to slope dirt/rock away from foundation. Thank you to Matt Hanel for mowing at the parsonage this summer. Pastor Janet will contact Guardian pest control to combat an ant problem and expected Asian beetle problem at the church.

Tony moved and Jim seconded to approve the committee reports.

Old Business:

Fair worship featuring Lorie Line went great. Travis participated in the service, reading scripture.

New Business:

The Bev Duckstad family will be donating their baby grand piano to Our Savior's. In the event the piano would no longer be needed, it would be returned to the Duckstad family.
